

# Rules

## What to bring

- BIBLE

- EXTRA BLANKET

- CASUAL DRESS CLOTHES (JEANS AND SHORTS)  
CAMP CLOTHES GET DIRTY. DON'T PACK ANYTHING THAT YOU WOULD BE UPSET ABOUT IF IT'S RUINED.
- INFORMAL DRESS CLOTHES (NO SHORTS) FOR EVENING MEALS AND WORSHIP SERVICES
- SHOES (BRING AND EXTRA PAIR FOR GAME TIME)
- JACKET
- CANTEEN MONEY (CAMPER'S HAVE THE OPTION TO BRING EXTRA MONEY FOR THE PURCHASE OF SNACKS DURING CANTEEN TIME. MONEY WILL BE COLLECTED AT CHECK-IN AND ANY MONEY NOT SPENT WILL BE RETURNED AT DEPARTURE. CAMPER'S ARE NOT ALLOWED TO KEEP CASH WITH THEM OR IN THEIR CABINS.)
- FRIENDS (LOTS OF THEM)



## What to leave at home

- All electronic equipment (CD, MP3 players, computers, iPods, cell phones,...) except hair dryers, curling irons, clocks and razors
- Tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs, weapons, food, candy
- Inappropriate clothing
  - short shorts (Your shorts must be mid thigh when sitting)
  - short skirts (They must cover the knees when sitting)
  - any shirts with pictures/slogans that would not be appropriate at a Christian camp
  - clothing that reveals too much skin or underclothing (showing midriffs or chest) - including spaghetti straps and tank tops
  - clothing that is too clingy or loose

ABA Camp is held at Camp Overlook in Mountain View, New York.

## DIRECTIONS from Malone:

- ~In Malone take State Route 30 South
- ~Go less than a mile to the top of the hill and turn left in front of the bowling alley
- ~Go straight two blocks
- ~Take a right onto Duane Street (towards Chasm Falls)
- ~At Chasm Falls the road forks; bear to the left at the fork (towards Owls Head)
- ~Just past the Catholic Church there will be a road to the right that takes you to Mountain View
- ~Go three miles
- ~You will see a large sign that says "Welcome to Mountain View" and the road will fork
- ~Stay to the left at the fork. There will be a 4-H Camp Overlook sign
- ~Go a couple hundred yards and take your first left
- ~This road will lead straight into Camp Overlook

## DIRECTIONS from the Tri-Lakes Area:

- ~On State Route 30, turn right onto County Route 99
- ~Follow this road (do not turn right when Route 99 turns, but go straight)
- ~Mountain View is about ten miles from Route 30
- ~Go straight into Mountain View, turn right after the one-lane bridge
- ~4-H Camp Overlook will be straight ahead
